# PORTABLE ESPRESSO MAKER

### WARNINGS

- Use only as directed.
- Not intended for children. Use adult supervision.

- Do not clean with strong detergent and solvent cleanser. See Care Instructions for cleaning.
- Clean before first time use and after each use.
- Use care, some parts are sharp and could cause injury if not handled correctly.

#### **CARE INSTRUCTIONS**

Clean before first time use and after each use.

- 1. Remove espresso capsule or ground coffee.
- 2. Add water with mild detergent into water reservoir and press down on plunger. Repeat process until water comes out clean.
- 3. Clean all detachable parts with water and mild detergent.
- 4. Dishwasher safe. For best results, place in top rack of dishwasher.

## TIPS AND SUGGESTIONS

For best results:

- Rinse water reservoir, espresso cup, and accessories with warm water before use.
- When using ground coffee, use freshly roasted coffee beans and grind right before use. It is preferable to use a medium-coarse grind.



#### **USE INSTRUCTIONS**

NOTE: Clean product prior to using.

#### **ESPRESSO CAPSULE INSTRUCTIONS**

- While espresso maker is completely assembled, twist water reservoir (B) counterclockwise to remove from grounds chamber (C) and set aside.
- Place espresso base (F) into grounds chamber, ensuring "This Side Up" text is facing up.
- Place espresso capsule (sold separately) into grounds chamber (C) with foil side down so it rests on espresso base.
- 4. Align tabs on espresso capsule holder (E) with internal slots of grounds chamber and slide until fully inserted into grounds chamber.
- 5. Twist water reservoir (B) onto grounds chamber (C), ensuring that the grounds chamber is sealed. You should encounter slight resistance as the espresso capsule holder punctures the capsule.
- Twist plunger (A) counterclockwise to remove, and fill water reservoir (B) with hot water to max fill line indicator. Put plunger back in place, being sure to seal water reservoir.
- Release plunger pump (J) by pressing down on top and turning 1/4 rotation in either direction until plunger pump pops up.
- 8. Hold over espresso cup and pump plunger rapidly until espresso stops coming out.
- 9. To lock plunger pump in place, push down and turn 1/4 rotation in either direction. Pump will pop slightly when it locks into place.







#### **GROUND COFFEE INSTRUCTIONS**

- While espresso maker is completely assembled, twist water reservoir (B) counterclockwise to remove from grounds chamber and set aside. Make sure espresso capsule holder base (F) is out of grounds chamber.
- 2. Remove lid (G) from ground coffee cup (H)
- 3. Fill ground coffee scoop (I) with freshly ground coffee.
- 4. Place ground coffee cup over ground coffee scoop and flip over to fill cup. Tap bottom of scoop to ensure all coffee grounds have been transferred and then remove scoop.
- 5. Place lid (G) onto ground coffee cup. With lid facing up, align tabs on ground coffee cup (H) with internal slots of grounds chamber and slide until fully inserted into grounds chamber.
- 6. Twist water reservoir (B) onto grounds chamber (C), ensuring that the grounds chamber is sealed.
- 7. Twist plunger (A) counterclockwise to remove, and fill water reservoir (B) with hot water to max fill line indicator. Put plunger back in place, being sure to seal water reservoir.
- 8. Release plunger pump (J) by pressing down on top and turning 1/4 rotation in either direction until plunger pops up.
- 9. Hold over coffee cup and pump plunger rapidly until coffee stops coming out.
- 10. To lock plunger pump in place, push down and turn 1/4 rotation in either direction. Plunger pump will pop slightly when it locks into place.

# NOTE: You may also make tea by following the instructions above but replacing ground coffee with loose leaf tea.
