- 1. MAIN FRAME
- 2. BASE BOARD
- 3. LEFT AND RIGHT PEDALS
- 4. BASE BOARD PEDALS AND RUBBER STANDS
- 5. ALLEN WRENCH
- 6. FRONT TUBE BOLTS
- 7. PEDAL BOLTS

ASSEMBLY

STEP 1 - FRONT TUBE ASSEMBLY





Attach the Front Tube to the Main Frame.

STEP 2 - BASE BOARD ASSEMBLY



Attach the Base Board to the Main Frame using the Base Board Bolts and Rubber Stands.

Tighten and secure the Base Board Bolts with the Allen Wrench.

STEP 3 - PEDAL ASSEMBLY



Attach the Left Pedal to the Left Pedal Arm with 2 bolts.

Tighten and secure the bolts with the Allen Wrench.

Repeat for the right pedal.

Note: The side without the raised lip of the pedal should be facing the away from the Main Frame.

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Requires 2 AAA Batteries (Included)

Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (NiCd, Ni-Mh, etc.) batteries.



1. Remove the display screen on top of the Pedal Pro to find the battery compartment.



2. Note the diagram inside the compartment that shows the correct battery installation polarity. Install 2 AAA batteries (included) according to the correct polarity.





3. Replace the display screen. Gently press down in place to ensure the cover is secure.

USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

ONLY USE THE PEDAL PRO WHILE SITTING



RESISTANCE ADJUSTMENT

The Pedal Pro has 8 levels of magnetic resistance that can be adjusted easily by foot. Use the adjustment lever to change the resistance level at any time during your workout. Adjusting resistance level will allow you to increase or decrease your intensity level. To lower or increase the resistance level, come to a complete stop and use feet to push up or down on the lever.

DISPLAY SCREEN



DISTANCE: Displays total distance traveled in MPH during workout session.

CALORIES: Displays total amount of calories burned during workout session.

ODOMETER: Displays total distance in MPH of all workouts combined.

RPM: Displays number of rotations per minute.

SCAN: Cycles through each display function.

TIME: Displays the total duration of the workout session.

STORAGE

The Pedal Pro comes with a built-in handle for easy portability and storage. The Pedal Pro can be stored underneath a work desk or table.
