General Overview

- Always wash your products thoroughly before first use.
- Tupperware products are durable and made for repeated use.
- Tupperware products are washable in standard household dishwashers on the top rack.

Microwave Products

- When using containers in a microwave oven, reheat only at low to medium power for a maximum of 3 minutes.
- If reheating more than 3 minutes, mix the contents occasionally to vent and release steam.
- Always mix contents before reheating and leave the lid flap open during reheating.
- Not freezer safe.
- Contents will be hot after reheating. Use heat-resistant oven gloves when handling.
- Always lift off the cover or lid away from you, so the steam does not burn you.
- If the container has a venting cap, open it before placing the sealed container in the microwave to prevent steam from building up.
- Reheat cooked foods from the refrigerator or at room temperature, but not directly from the freezer.
- Never leave the microwave oven unattended during use.

Maintenance

- Do not use abrasive cleaning pads or abrasive cleaners, as these will scratch the containers.
- Scrape off solid foods before putting containers in the dishwasher. Avoid rinsing to conserve water. If the
 containers were used with "sticky" products or have persistent odors, fill the containers with a mixture of baking
 soda (1 to 2 tablespoons per quart or liter of warm water) and let them soak for a few hours, then rinse and air
 dry.

Good to Know

- Avoid contact with all sources of heat such as a conventional oven, hot plate, flame, hot fat, grill, etc.
- Do not expose your closed containers to direct sunlight.
- Do not cut or use sharp objects inside of or against the containers.
- If a new lid does not fit well on a container, then soak the lid for 10 minutes in water at 185 °F (85 °C). Let it cool before touching, and then place it on the container.
