Anna Griffin® 12x12 Perfect Palette (290-940) - 1 sheet of hot pink

Anna Griffin® 12x12 Metallic Cardstock - 1 sheet of light pink

Xyron 5 in. Creative Station with Permanent Adhesive Cartridge

4x6" photo, floral embellishments, title sticker and journaling tag

- Using the paper trimmer, cut 3, 2.5" strips from both of the 12x12" hot pink and light pink cardstock paper (total of 6, 2.5 x 12" strips).
- Apply Xyron adhesive to the back of all 6 strips. Leave the strips on the backing paper.
- Cut and emboss 1 hot pink strip and 1 light pink strip with Die #1.
- Cut and emboss 2 hot pink strips and 2 light pink strips with Die #2.
- With the piercing tool, push out the negative pieces from the light pink die cuts #1 and #2. Set aside. Repeat with the hot pink die cut #1.
- Gently peel off the white adhesive backing and attach the hot pink die cuts #2 to the 12x12" floral cardstock. Repeat with the hot pink and light pink die cuts #1
- Remove the adhesive backing on the light pink negative pieces from die cut #2. Inlay the pieces by inserting them into the hot pink die cuts #2 on the floral cardstock. Repeat with the with the hot pink and light pink die cut #1.

You'll have 2 light pink die cuts #2 leftover to use on another project.
